AVINGTON PLACE COMMON AREA POND USE RULES & REGULATIONS

The pond is for the enjoyment of all homeowners within the community and their guests.

- 1. Swimming and wading in the pond is **prohibited.**
- 2. Community access to the pond from the common areas only.
- 3. Permission to access any other area of the pond should be obtained from each individual homeowner that lives on the pond.
- 4. Only "Catch & Release" fishing is permitted.
- 5. Small non-motorized boats, paddleboats, or canoes are permitted on the pond. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 6. North Carolina State Small Craft Safety Standards and Regulations <u>must</u> be followed while on the pond. Lifejackets are required.
- 7. Boats may not be stored on the banks of the pond.
- 8. No tampering of rocks in drainage areas.
- 9. Littering in or around the pond is prohibited.
- 10. As with any water activity, for your safety, it is *highly recommended* that individuals never access the pond alone.
- 11. The Avington Place Community Association is not responsible for any injury or incident that may occur in or around the pond area. **Use of pond area is at your own risk.**
